Subject: - Disbursement of Medical claims of ailing Kashmiri Migrants.

**Government Order No. 35 Rev/MR of 2015
D a t e d : - 19-02-2015**

Pursuant to decision taken by Empowered Committee in its meeting held on 13-2-2015 and in supersession to Government Order No. 96-Rev/MR/36/2007 dated. 14-03-2007, Government Order No. 199-Rev/MR/2008 dated. 02-08-2008, Sanction is hereby accorded to the following amendments in the Jammu and Kashmir Migrants welfare fund Rules 2007:-

- a) Patients with chronic diseases and requiring hospitalization/surgeries shall be entitled for advance payment by way of transfer of the said amount directly to the hospitals as per the actual estimated cost received from the hospitals for the treatment of Migrant patients, subject to a maximum ceiling of Rs.5.00 lac per patient.
Preference shall be given to such cases where the estimates are received from the Government owned hospitals, however private hospitals can also be considered for transfer of amount subject to the condition that these hospitals fall within the list of recognized medical institutions as per the medical attendance rules of the State.
- b) With regard to the life consuming diseases, the patients shall be re-imbursed amount incurred by them on purchase of medicines only after the vouchers are certified by the Head of the Department of recognized hospital and countersigned by concerned officer to be designated by the health Department. However, the annual ceiling of such reimbursement shall be Rs 2.00 lacs per patient.
- c) With regard to other ailments where hospitalization/surgery is required the migrant patient shall be re-imbursed expenses incurred upto Rs. 1.00 lacs per annum and in case the Relief Commissioner certifies that the patient requires such amount in advance same can be considered by the Empowered Committee, however such facility shall be available on case to case basis, the Patient shall be entitled for the reimbursement/payment subject to condition that the hospital falls in the list of institutes figured in the medical attendance rules of the State.
- d) Whenever the amount is required to be transferred to hospital in respect of category No. a above, Relief Commissioner after receiving the estimates shall transfer the amount to the concerned hospital

within 6 days, however he shall be at liberty to consult the Director Health Services in this regard, if otherwise required and subsequently the matter shall be placed for confirmation before the designated Committee. Director Health services shall convey his agreement/disagreement within three days after receiving such cases from Relief Commissioner (M).

- e) Following three Committee have also been constituted to sanction claims as per delegation shown against each:-

- f) Empowered Committee shall meet on 8th of every month for considering claims above Rs 2.50 lacs. In case no claim of Rs.2.50 lacs and above is received from the Relief Organization in that case, the Revenue Department shall apprise Chief Secretary in advance accordingly.
- g) In case, any migrant patient requires amount exceeding the ceiling as fixed above, in that case such cases shall be referred to the Finance Department and Red Cross for sanctioning of the balance amount.


