Whereas on the basis of indent placed by Executive Engineer, PW(R&B) Division, Kishtwar, a notification under section 4 (1) was issued by Collector, Land Acquisition (ACR) Kishtwar, vide No. ADC/LA/K/62-68/2016 dated 07-10-2016, for land measuring 02 Kanals and 14 Marlas, situated in village Kishtwar, Tehsil & District Kishtwar.

Whereas the Collector Land Acquisition, (ACR) Kishtwar vide No. ACR/LA/K/16/95 dated 13-12-2016 has reported that the notification issued under section 4 (1) of the J&K State Land Acquisition Act by him was served upon the interested persons for filing objections, if any, to the proposed acquisition, but, no objection was received from the land owners/ interested persons within the prescribed period as required under sections 5 & 5-A of the Land Acquisition Act.

Whereas, the report furnished by Collector Land Acquisition (ACR) Kishtwar, vide above referred letter duly endorsed by District Collector, (DC) Kishtwar, vide No. DCK/LA/2016/473-77 dated 31-01-2017, has been examined and it has been found that the land owners did not file any objection to the proposed acquisition; and

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the land particulars whereof are given above, is required for public purpose viz construction of construction of link road from Cherhar to Bonjwar;

Now therefore, in pursuance of Section 6 of the J&K State Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 02 Kanals and 14 Marlas, situated in village Village Kishtwar, Tehsil & District Kishtwar, particulars whereof are given above, is required for public purposes viz for construction of link road from Cherhar to Bonjwar. Further, the Collector Land Acquisition (ACR), Kishtwar is directed under section 7 of the said Act to take orders for acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interested person (S) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/rules.

However, the Collector concerned shall be personally responsible for identification and proper title verification of all types of land involved in the case for making apportionment of compensation amongst all the interested persons/ rightful claimants, in accordance with the relevant laws/ rules in force, while making the award.
