1. To propose the pattern of seeding the legacy data to make it easily accessible/ searchable by the users.
2. To determine the Meta-data for assorting the seeded data to bring it on a uniform pattern. For this purpose, the Committee may study the seeded legacy data of other states as well.
3. To suggest the standard technical specifications and hardware requirement in SDC for hosting of the legacy data on short term (1999-2019) and long-term basis (1920 - 1999).
4. Any other ancillary issue related to legacy data management on which the Committee may like to advise.

The Committee shall submit its report by or before 23.03.2022




